

Imported Assessments - ANGEL to Blackboard

Clean up:

The following items regarding tests should be checked by faculty members upon the transition to Blackboard.

- Some images may not come over. These will need to be re-uploaded and added to questions.
- Fill-in-the-Blank questions import correctly. However, in order to function correctly, these questions need to be edited. Once inside the question, insert the blank and add the correct answer(s).
- Upon import, subtitles are dropped. The title of the question will need to be edited if the subtitle information still needs to be visible.
- The Question Settings will need to be manually updated once the tests are in Blackboard.
 - Find the test in the content area of the course. Click on the arrow in the right hand corner of the imported test and choose “Edit The Test >Question Settings” and update as needed. Settings in this area include:
 - Allowing the option to provide feedback for individual answers
 - Allowing images, files and web links to be added to questions/answers
 - Allowing keywords, levels of difficulty and instructor notes for questions to be added
 - Specifying a default point value
 - Questions copied from ANGEL will still have the letter next to the answer option (A-D). However, any new question created in Blackboard will *not by default*. This setting can be changed under “Edit The Test>Question Settings”.
 - Also, be sure to check the settings under “Edit The Test Options” to change the test dates, make the test available to students, select the type of feedback (or disable it), etc.

Keep In Mind...

- Assessments in ANGEL that had the question order set to “Randomized” now import as a question set within Blackboard.
- Assessments that used Questions Pools in ANGEL are imported as a “Random Block” within Blackboard.
- Question Pools in ANGEL import as a “Pool” within Blackboard. These may also be deployed as a test to the content area.
